Ritenour High School Student Designs New School Flag

July 20, 2009 – Ritenour High School (RHS) officially has a new school flag. Upcoming junior Steven Stevens created the flag's design, which prominently features the Ritenour Husky and has many intricate details – highlighting the proud history and outstanding tradition at RHS.

“As we were talking about politics and change in our American Politics class last semester, students came up with the idea that Ritenour High School needed a school flag, something we didn't have at the time,” explained RHS social studies instructor Catherine Lampshire. “So, the class decided to have a contest to design a new flag. Our students organized the competition and distributed flyers throughout the school. We had many outstanding entries.”

In all, 35 original designs entered the competition, all from RHS students. A committee of students, teachers and administrators chose Stevens design.

The new flag will be officially introduced to students during an assembly at the beginning of next school year. It is currently flying at RHS and is located on the northwest corner of Moore Field.
