I-270 is one of the oldest freeways in the United States. The I-270 North Environmental Assessment is studying proposed improvements from the I-70 interchange on the west to the Chain of Rocks Bridge on the east. It is the next step in addressing: congestion; safety; mobility (the movement of people or goods); accessibility to area businesses and residences; and aging infrastructure. If nothing is done, these issues will continue to worsen.
